STALL RESERVATION DEADLINE: DUE TO STALL LIMITATIONS, RESERVATION & PAYMENT
(OR "OPEN" CHECK) FOR STALL RESERVATIONS **MUST** BE POSTMARKED BY SEPTEMBER 15.
STALL FEES: **\$70** IF POSTMARKED BY SEPTEMBER 15, **\$85** AFTER SEPTEMBER 15.

NO DEADLINE FOR ENTRIES: PRE-ENTRY BY SEPTEMBER 15 DOES NOT HAVE TO BE ACCOMPANIED BY A CHECK FOR CLASS ENTRIES
– Exhibitors passes will be sold at gate. Gate passes will be given out at gate as you enter the grounds.

Stalls are pre-assigned, check in with Stable Manager upon arrival. Stall space is limited and will be assigned by postmark. To enable cleanout, stalls cannot be guaranteed until 6 p.m. Friday.

GROUNDS FEE - \$10 ONE TIME FEE REQUIRED OF ALL HORSES NOT USING STALLS.

PASSES - Exhibitor Passes will be given at gate on the following scale per owner: 1-2 horses-2 passes, 3 or more horses-3 passes. Additional passes may be purchased at the gate for \$10 (MAXIMUM 4 PER OWNER OR TRAINER), dated for the same days as the show. The Exhibitor Passes and Exhibitor Sale tickets will be turned in at exhibitor gate and exchanged for a wristband, which is color coded for the dates of the show or competition. Exhibitor credentials provide admission to Fair only and do not include rides.

PARKING - Appropriate decal will be affixed to animal hauling vehicle upon arrival. When/If exhibitor/participant lots are full, vehicles will be directed to park in overflow General Parking. If you do not have a parking decal or pass, you will have to pay \$5.00 to park in General Parking, like the general public.

CAMPING - \$30 per night Reservations will be taken on a first-come, first-serve basis by faxing the 'State Fair RV Space Reservation Form to 804.569.3251. This form can be found on www.statefair.com (click 'competitions'); faxing this form is the ONLY way reservations will be accepted. **No Trailers, campers, RVs, etc. will be allowed to plug into barn, stable or ring hook-ups.**

DRUG TESTING - All horses entered in AQHA/PHBA classes shall be subject to drug testing endorsed by the American Quarter Horse Association and VQHA. \$6.00 AQHA/\$10 PHBA for weekend (All Breed non-AQHA/PHBA classes exempt).

LIABILITY - Upon submission of entry blank, exhibitor releases and waives all rights against the State Fair of Virginia and its officers, directors, employees, agents or representatives for death, personal injury or property damage and waives the right to sue or to bring action against the State Fair of Virginia, the Superintendent of the Show or any employees of the Superintendent for any loss or damage which is in any way connected with the risks involved in equine activity.

PHOTOS - Anyone participating in any competition at the State Fair of Virginia consents to the use of the Fair's photographic image of them or their exhibit, by the State Fair of Virginia, its parent, agents, licensees, and assigns for any and all purposes. Exhibitor understands there will be no remuneration for the use of such image.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS - ALL HORSES MUST HAVE A NEGATIVE COGGINS TEST DATED WITHIN THE LAST TWELVE MONTHS PRIOR TO THE SHOW DATE. ALL HORSES MUST ADHERE TO CURRENT INTERSTATE AND INTRASTATE HEALTH REQUIREMENTS. THE SHOW WILL ADHERE TO FEDERAL HORSE PROTECTION REGULATIONS.
